- Where necessary assist with service/ maintenance of equipment
- Data input on spread sheets
- Stock checking
- Under guidelines from Team Leader fulfil requirements required for working day
- Attend internal meetings when required
- Maintaining a good level of housekeeping in Lamp Room
- Assisting other departments in ION Science as needed
- Flexible to do overtime if required
